Students plant trees for the future

More than 350 students got their hands dirty as they planted close to 1,400 seedlings on Friday 9 August as part of the 12th annual Lakelands Tree Planting Day – check out the video on the [Lakelands Estate Facebook page](#)!

This year's planting day brings the total number of seedlings planted throughout the Lakelands community to almost 20,000 over more than a decade as part of this initiative.

Mandurah Baptist College students from years three to six along with a group of home-schooled students joined senior students from the College's Integrated Science Course, and conservationists from Tranen Revegetation Systems.

Over the course of five sessions, each student planted seedlings, leaving a lasting impact on the new park bordered by Tonalli Circuit and Dragonfly Boulevard, which is currently under construction.

The Stage 67 parklands are due for completion in late Spring and will include a significant grassed area, picnic tables and shade structure, landscaped garden beds and retained vegetation. There will also be a pendulum swing, play net and log tunnels to keep the kids entertained!

Development *update*

Welcome to the latest edition of the Lakelands community newsletter. It's been a busy winter at Lakelands Estate with a host of community events enjoyed by locals as well as a raft of development activity happening across the estate.

Construction of Stage 68 is progressing well and is expected to be complete in November this year. As part of this stage a new temporary road connection from Lilydale Drive in Lakelands Estate to Stock Road has been constructed and was opened at the end of last month.

Two parks are currently under construction – the Stage 67 Park on Dragonfly Boulevard was the location of the recent Tree Planting Day activities (see main story Page 1), and the Stage 66 Triangle Park adjacent to Paganoni Lake which will feature a viewing deck and an extension of the popular boardwalk. Both parks are expected to be completed and open for the community to enjoy in coming months.

A special thank you to the local students who took part in the planting day and I look forward to watching those seedlings grow over the coming years.

It's also great to see so many residents getting involved in the community and hosting new, local events like the Repair Café and Sustainability Design workshops.

Spreading the sustainability message

Sustainable homes with features such as solar panels and natural heating and cooling mechanisms with high environmental ratings have become an increasing trend around Australia.

Lakelands residents Mike and Jan Fawcett joined forces with leading passive solar home designer Solar Dwellings, Lakelands Estate and the City of Mandurah to educate locals on the importance of sustainable homes and how to design one at an affordable price through a series of free workshops.

“One of the reasons we chose our block in Lakelands was because it was perfectly positioned for an energy efficient home and we were able to incorporate sustainable design solutions during construction,” said Mike

“The location of windows and your choice of floor coverings can have a positive impact on the retention of heat, can maximise cooling effects in the home and ultimately help to reduce utility expenses.”

“Building a sustainable home is affordable,” said Jan. “For house, land and sustainable design we built for \$380,000 – the same as what it's costing others.”

Chairperson of the working group, Michael Gorman said it was really inspiring to see such a passionate group of people come together.

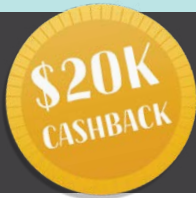
“To see our community come together and share their ideas and ultimately put their support behind establishing a community garden in Lakelands was incredible,” said Michael.

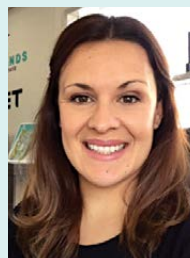
