
What you can do

How Know Your Neighbour works

- 1 Decide what type of event you want to host (eg BBQ, afternoon tea, drinks) and decide on a time and location.
- 2 Register your event to go in the draw to win some great prizes. You can complete the attached form or complete the form online at

wanneroo.wa.gov.au/knowyourneighbour

- 3 Make some invites. You can make your own, or you can use the template provided to you when you register your BBQ, or ask us to send you some printed invites.
- 4 Invite your neighbours.
- 5 Host your event most importantly have fun! This is a chance to get to know the people who live around you.
- 6 You may want to encourage everyone to share their contact details on a neighbourhood contact sheet, which can help you all to stay in touch and could be essential during an emergency.

Tips for hosts

- Take the time to invite people face to face, people will feel more comfortable coming along if they have already met you.
- Ask people to bring their own food so that people can share and it keeps costs and waste down for everyone.
- Be sure to introduce people to each other as they arrive.
- Games are a great way to get people talking and having fun. The City of Wanneroo has cricket sets available for loan for free at all of the local libraries that you like to use at your event.
- At your event, encourage your neighbours to host the next event. This will help to grow your neighbourly spirit and they too can go in the draw to win prizes!
